- white car has been parking on the pavement outside Bedfield House - police to be contacted.

- Village 30 - it is unclear when this actually comes into force as there are still some work to be done in relation to signage etc.
- Notice Boards - quotation received for new notice board at bottom of Nations Hill which was accepted and to be installed as soon as possible.
Councillor Stephens to visit owner of Good Life Farm Shop to discuss the parish council notice board and the location of it.
- Litter Pick Up - concerns expressed about litter being dumped in Wellhouse Lane.
- School Lane - bench is on order and should be replaced soon.
- Potholes - concerns raised about potholes especially at junction of Bedfield Lane and Worthy road, also large one in carriageway of A33 near Cart and Horses.

7. NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH

The police team would like an item on the agenda for community safety which will be incorporated into neighbourhood watch on future agendas.

The three priorities given to the police service for Headbourne Worthy were fly tipping in Wellhouse lane, excessive speed and lack of visible police presence.
