We have had all our metal shelters (except those owned by Adshell) cleaned, painted and the clear panel replaced where needed

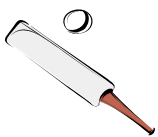
We hope this will make waiting for the bus or driving or walking along our roads a more pleasant experience
