A34 Kings Worthy Flyover

I am writing to inform you that the Highways Agency will be undertaking essential maintenance work to replace the safety barrier located along the A33 Winchester Bypass northbound link road from the A34. A new higher containment safety barrier will be installed to protect the bridge support columns for the Kings Worthy Flyover.


The works are scheduled to start on 23 February 2011 and should take approximately 5 weeks to complete, weather permitting. To reduce disruption to road users and for the safety of the site staff, traffic management will be in place under the flyover. This will include a realigned narrow lane on the Winchester Bypass link road and a restricted speed limit of 40mph.

From 10pm on Wednesday 23 February until 5.30am on Thursday 24 February, there will be a full overnight closure of the northbound A33 link road between its split with the A34 and the B3047 London Road, to enable the traffic management to be installed. Further full overnight closures of the link road will be required at end of the scheme for the removal of the traffic management.

Whilst the full closures are in place, there will be a clearly signed diversion route via the Three Maids Hill roundabout, Andover Road, Worthy Lane and London Road.
